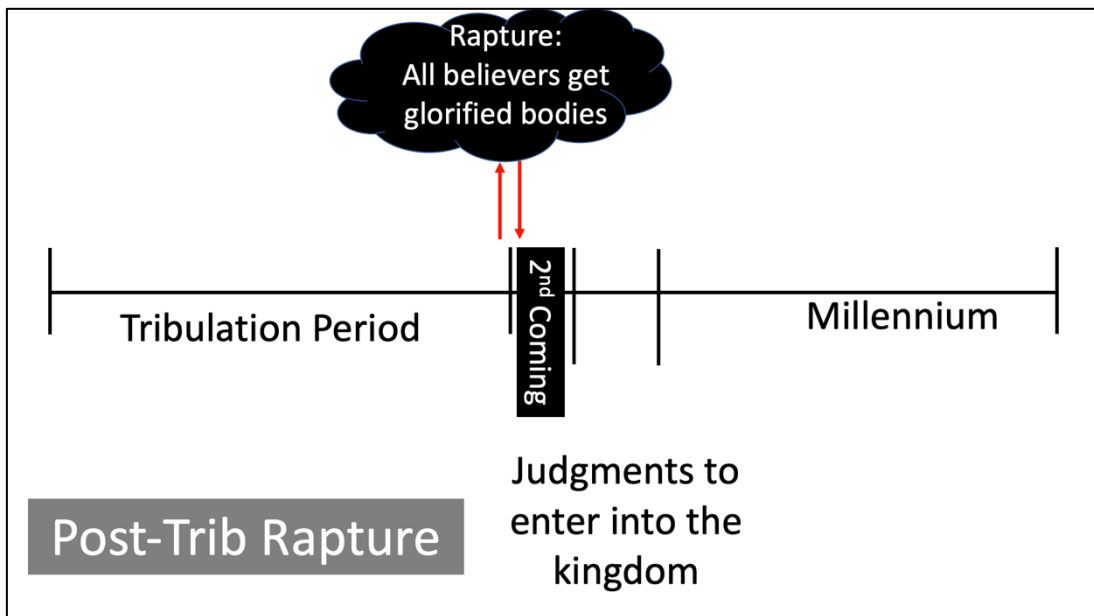
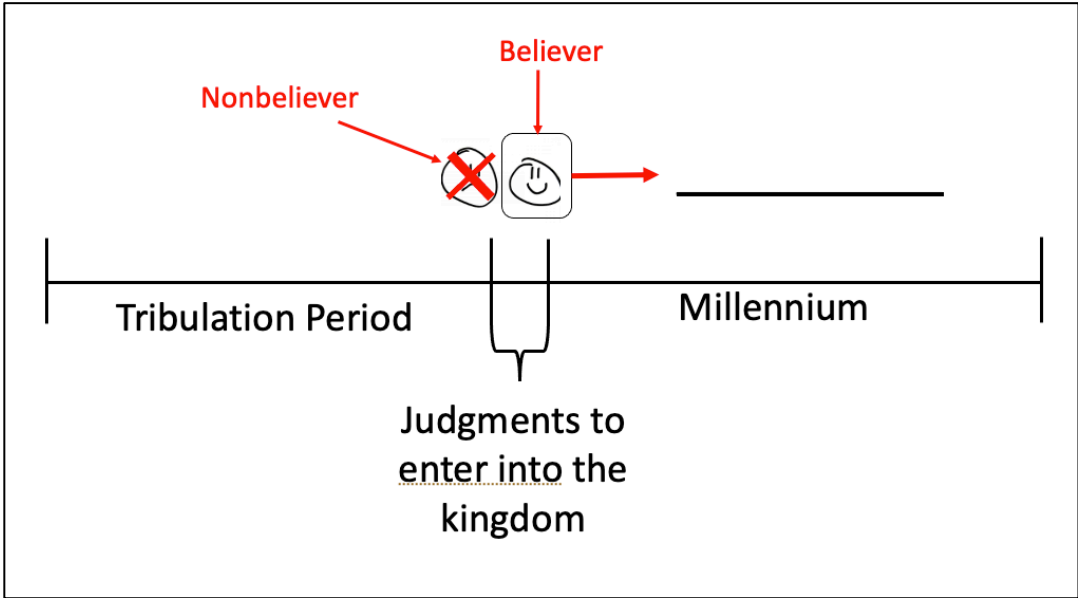

Saved are delivered from wrath	Unsaved experience wrath

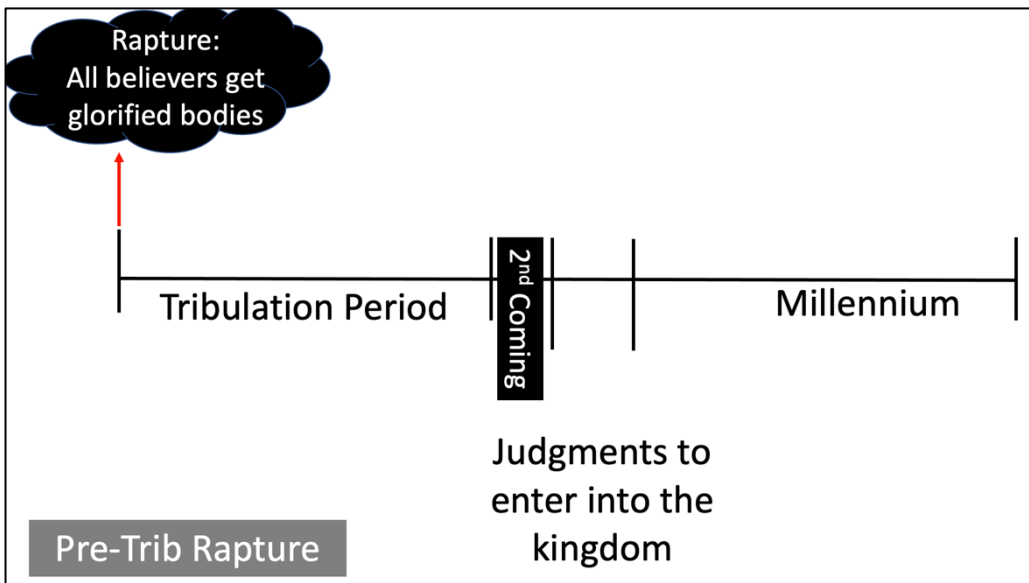
