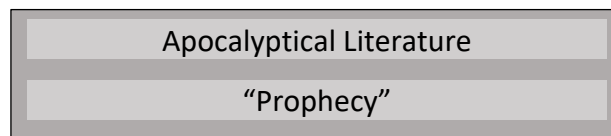
Revelation 1:1-3

The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show His servants—things which must shortly take place. And He sent and signified *it* by His angel to His servant John, who bore witness to the word of God, and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, to all things that he saw. Blessed *is* he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time *is* near.

- The translation of Revelation in the Greek is apokalypsis
 - Uncovering
 - Unveiling
- The main idea is not about end times but about seeing Jesus Christ
- Satan hates the book of Revelation
 - Satan tries to keep people from reading this book
 - Why? This speaks of his defeat
- The adversary, that is tempting you, has already been defeated
- The book tells the glorious victory of Jesus Christ
- It is the only book of the Bible that attaches a blessing if you read it

- **Hermeneutics** – Methodological Principles of Interpreting Scripture



- The Lord meant for us to understand the book of Revelation
- Most of what is in the book is not new information
- There are hundreds of references to the Old Testament
- Understanding the symbols
 - Let scripture interpret scripture

Three Prophetic Understandings

- Fact
(No one can buy or sell without the mark)
- Assumption
(Example: Cashless Society)
- Speculation
(Example: Chips tha control commerce)

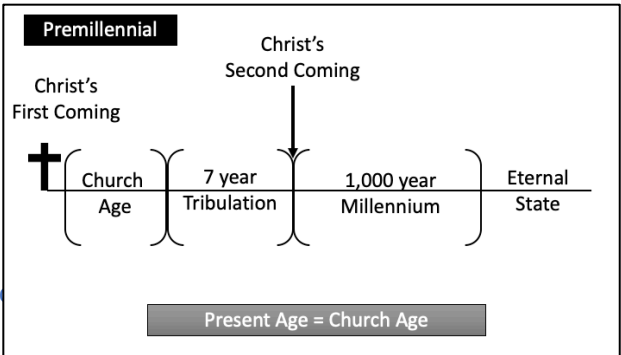
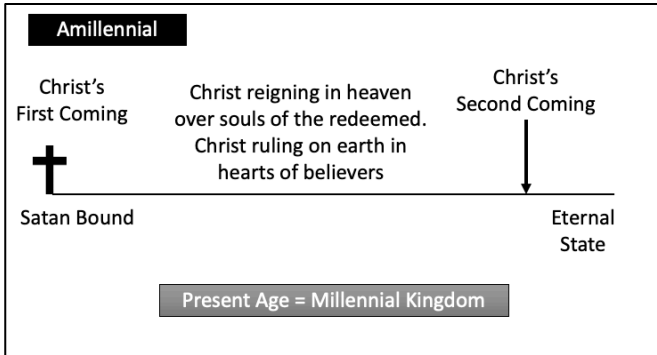
Revelation 13:17
So tht they could not buy or sell unless they had the mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of its name.

Premillennialism vs. Amillennialism

Revelation 20:1-2
And I saw an angel coming down out of heaven, having the key to the Abyss and holding in his hand a great chain. He seized the dragon, or Satan, and bound him for a thousand years

Amillennialism	Premillennialism
<u>Figurateive</u> Intepretation	<u>Literal</u> Intepretation

Amillennial	Premillennial
A (not) – no literal thousand reign of Christ (or tribulation period)	Literal thousand-year reign of Christ
Examples: Presbyterian, Lutheran, Reformed, Catholic	Examples: C&MA, Baptist, Fundamentalists
Christ rules over a spiritual kingdom in hearts of believers on earth and over the souls of the redeemed in heaven (Spiritual Reign)	Christ will rule personally for one thousand years over a literal, physical, earthly kingdom with Satan bound and the curse of the fall removed



The Rapture

Jesus snatching the church up in the air

- “Harpazo” to snatch up
- Saints will receive glorified Bodies (1 Corinthians 15:51-51)
- Three main views
 - Pretribulation
 - Midtribulation
 - Posttribulation

1 Thessalonians 4:17

After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.

Second Coming of Christ

Jesus comes to the earth to set-up His kingdom

Keeping the Distinction

Rapture – the church being caught up in the air.

- Three Views
 - Pre-trib (before the tribulation)
 - Mid-trib (middle of tribulation)
 - Post-trib (end of tribulation)

Second Coming – Christ coming back to the earth to set up his kingdom

Millennium – the thousand-year reign of Christ on earth

- Two main views
 - Amillennial (does not believe in a literal one thousand-year reign of Christ)
 - Premillennial (Literal one thousand-year reign of Christ)

Question #1 – Is the United States mentioned in prophecy?

- The United States is not mentioned in prophecy

Some Different Scholarly Opinions

Option 1

America is not mentioned because she will be destroyed by other nations

Option 2

America is not mentioned in Bible prophecy because she will have lost her influence as a result of moral and spiritual deterioration (internal rot)

She may have made a treaty with the antichrist which comes from European area and plays a minor role

Option 3

If the rapture is pre-trib, America may be crippled with the loss of Christians

A confederacy of ten nations that the Anti-Christ will rule from the area of the Ancient Roman Empire

Section 5: Basic Chronological Timeline

Beginning of the Tribulation Period

- Seven years
- The Anti-Christ signs a peace treaty with Israel
 - It appears the first seal - white horse
- The Jewish temple is (or has been) rebuilt
- Pre-trib Viewpoint – The rapture has taken place

Daniel 9:27

He will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.' In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him.

Revelation 6:1-2

I watched as the Lamb opened the first of the seven seals. Then I heard one of the four living creatures say in a voice like thunder, "Come!" I looked, and there before me was a white horse! Its rider held a bow, and he was given a crown, and he rode out as a conqueror bent on conquest.

Represents peace

It has a bow but no arrows

Conquers without war but peace

This provides a false peace on earth

Middle of the Tribulation Period

- The Anti-Christ breaks his peace with Israel
- The Anti-Christ sets up the abomination of desolation
- Great Tribulation
- Mark of the Beast
- Remnant of Israel flees

End of the Tribulation Period

- The Anti-Christ's power is breaking apart
- Bowl judgments are poured out in rapid succession
- Babylon is destroyed (Revelation 17-18)
- Battle of Armageddon (campaign of battles)
- Christ returns and slays the armies gathered against him
- The birds gather to feast on the carnage (Revelation 19:17-18)
